Preparation

First, print out the wheel of fortune sheet and paste it onto a round wooden or cardboard board.
Then, attach an arrow to the center of the board using a nail or a screw.
Make sure the arrow can spin freely and point clearly to each section

How to Play

Players take turns spinning the wheel.
When the wheel stops, follow the instruction on the section where the arrow lands.
If a task is completed successfully, the player earns points or a reward.
If the task is failed, the turn moves to the next player.

Winning the Game:

The player with the most points at the end of the game wins.
Alternatively, set a time limit or number of rounds to determine the winner.

Rules

No spinning the wheel more than once per turn.
Players must follow the instruction exactly as written.
Any disputes are settled by the game moderator or teacher.
