## Preparation

- First, print out the wheel of fortune sheet and paste it onto a round wooden or cardboard board.
- Then, attach an arrow to the center of the board using a nail or a screw.
- Make sure the arrow can spin freely and point clearly to each section

## How to Play

- Players take turns spinning the wheel.
- When the wheel stops, follow the instruction on the section where the arrow lands.
- If a task is completed successfully, the player earns points or a reward.
- If the task is failed, the turn moves to the next player.

## Winning the Game:

- The player with the most points at the end of the game wins.
- Alternatively, set a time limit or number of rounds to determine the winner.

## Rules

- No spinning the wheel more than once per turn.
- Players must follow the instruction exactly as written.
- Any disputes are settled by the game moderator or teacher.
